- o Applications are due on January 24th by 11:59 pm. Late applications will not be accepted.

- o Phases of Competition:
 - Interview 35%
 - Opening Number
 - Lifestyle/Active Wear
 - Talent 25%
 - Onstage Question 15%
 - Evening Wear 25%
- o Scholarship Monies are dependent on our pre pageant ad and ticket sales.
- o Rehearsal Week will be March 23rd, 24th, 26th & 27th. These dates are MANDATORY and you are expected to be on time. There will be no school that Monday, BUT WE WILL STILL BE PRACTICING. This is NOT a school-sponsored pageant/event.
- o Pageant Day will consist of Interviews in the mid morning to afternoon and you will be dismissed after your interview until the pageant that night. You will be expected to be at the High School Auditorium by 5pm for pageant start time at 7pm.
- o What's expected:
 - o Think of your application as a job or college application. Make sure it is proofread and checked twice before submitting. Should we have over 15 applicants, we will do a prelim based off your 300 word or less essay. The essays will be sent off to an outside Optimist Club for selection and you will be contacted by February 1st. Should you make the top 15, your application will be the only thing the judges see before meeting you.
 - o We expect absolute punctuality to all mandatory events, communication from you the participant directly, hitting your deadlines and NO EXCUSES. We also expect respect for the pageant volunteers, your fellow contestants and yourself.
